Just FYI: Current cost to a pilgrim for the walk is \$100.00. It cost the Community \$156.00 per pilgrim per walk. Current cost to a team member is also \$100.00, with a cost of \$120.00. As some of you may know, Lakeshore is undergoing a remodel to some of the cabins. Cabin 12 has been designated for us, the WTEC, as a project to pay for renovation. This cabin is used during the walks for all of the speakers to prepare and get ready before their talks. A remodel is approximately \$10,000.00. Currently, we have received about \$600.00 in donations toward this remodel. We have about 6000 members in our Community. What a great way to give back to Lakeshore and a wonderful tribute for each of us to remember and honor our own walk and time spent at Lakeshore.
